(a) Familiar from linear algebra and vector calculus is a parametrized line: Given points P and Q in \mathbb{R}^3 , we let $v = \frac{1}{\|PQ\|}(Q - P)$ and set $r(t) = P + tv$, $t \in \mathbb{R}$. Note that $r(0) = P$, $r(1) = Q$, and for $0 \leq t \leq 1$, $r(t)$ is on the line segment PQ . We ask the reader to check in Exercise 8 that of all paths from P to Q , the "straight line path" r gives the shortest.
